Durley Parish Council is writing to you to ask for your help with our efforts in working with Southern Water to find a resolution to the ongoing issues with the sewer network within our village.

As I am sure you are aware, the main issue relates to surface water entering the sewer network and overloading the pumping station in Heathen Street. This is resulting in sewage flooding onto the roads and lanes within our village and even into properties, particularly in Heathen Street.

What Durley Parish Council are asking you all to do is to keep a look out for any flooding within the village, particularly after rainfall. This flooding could be on the roadways, verges, fields or gardens, literally anywhere within the village. If you do see any flooding, please make a note of where, and when it is occurring and let us know. If you could include a photograph or two of the flooding it would help.

We would also like to know if you have received one of the free rain butts that Southern Water delivered recently. If you did receive one and are happy to let us know your address, it would be appreciated as we can then see the overall picture of where the water butts are placed in the village.

If you could send the details of the location of the flooding, and any photographs of flooding to floodingindurley@gmail.com, or drop a note into the post box at Durley Memorial Hall that would be very helpful.

Durley and its residents do not deserve to have a sewage system that does not work, and those residents who are directly impacted by it need it to stop. Let us do all we can to help resolve this issue as soon as possible – it has gone on long enough.
